

# Payroll Giving

**You can make a difference to local people in our care by regularly donating through Payroll Giving (also known as Give as you Earn or Workplace Giving). This an easy way to make a regular tax-free gift to St Helena Hospice directly through your salary.**

## How does Payroll Giving work?

Choose the amount you wish to donate and each payday it will be deducted automatically through your salary. The tax on that donation will be given by the government, which means St Helena Hospice receive more money at no extra cost to you!

For example:

<b>Pledge to St Helena Hospice</b>	<b>Cost to you as taxpayer (20%)</b>	<b>Cost to you as taxpayer (40%)</b>	<b>St Helena Hospice receive</b>
£5	£4	£3	£5
£10	£8	£6	£10
£15	£12	£9	£15
£20	£16	£12	£20
£50	£40	£30	£50
