

Community Fun Day - Saturday 3rd August 2024

Terms and conditions

1. Introduction

1.1 These booking terms and conditions apply to everyone attending the St Helena Hospice Community Fun Day. Upon entry you accept these terms and conditions.

2. Admission, donations, and parking

- 2.1. The event offers free admission to all attendees. Donations to support the event and its charitable causes are welcome but not required.
- 2.2. Parking is available on site for a fee of £2 per car. However, parking is limited, so attendees are advised to walk, carpool, or use public transportation when possible. A park and ride service may be available; please refer to the event website for more information on park and ride locations and times.
- 2.3. Please follow the instructions of parking attendants and park only in designated areas.

3. Health, safety, and responsibility

- 3.1. Your safety and the safety of others is paramount. Please follow all safety guidelines, event rules, and instructions from event staff.
- 3.2. If you or someone else requires medical attention, notify event staff immediately.
- 3.3. Pets are welcome at the event but must be always kept on a lead. Owners are responsible for their pets' behaviour and must clean up after them. Aggressive pets may be asked to leave the event.
- 3.4. Parents and guardians are responsible for the supervision and behaviour of their children at all times. Unattended children may be separated from the event until a parent or guardian is located.
- 3.5. Licensed bars are available at the event. Attendees are expected to drink responsibly. The organisers accept no liability for issues arising from excessive or irresponsible drinking. Security will be on site to ensure a safe environment for everyone.
- 3.6. The event is a smoke free and drug free environment. Violations of these rules may result in removal from the event.



- 3.4. Parents and guardians are responsible for the supervision and behaviour of their children at all times. Unattended children may be separated from the event until a parent or guardian is located.
- 3.5. The Event is smoke free and drug free. Alcohol consumption is not permitted unless designated in a specific area for adults over the legal drinking age.

4. Dog show

- 4.1. The event includes a dog show, which is open to attendees with pets. Specific rules and categories for the dog show will be provided at the event.
- 4.2. Dogs must be always on a lead. Owners must ensure their pets do not cause harm or disruption to other attendees or dogs.
- 4.3. Participation in the dog show is at your own risk. The event organisers are not liable for injuries or accidents related to the dog show.
- 4.4. Owners must ensure their dogs are under control and should bring waste bags to clean up after their pets.
- 4.5. Any aggressive behaviour from dogs or irresponsible behaviour from owners will result in disqualification from the dog show and possible removal from the event.
- 4.6. We kindly request that you refrain from using prong collars on your dogs.
- 4.7. We ask that you do not bring dogs that are in season.
- 4.8. There will be 14 classes as part of the event and all classes will be £2 per dog, per class.
- 4.9. All dogs listed under the dangerous dogs act are exempt from competing in the show.

5. Code of conduct

- 5.1. All attendees, volunteers, and staff must treat each other with respect and courtesy.
- 5.2. Disruptive, discriminatory, or harmful behaviour will not be tolerated. This includes but is not limited to harassment, violence, bullying, or discrimination based on race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or other protected characteristics.
- 5.3. Organisers reserve the right to remove individuals who violate the code of conduct.

6. Photography and media

6.1 We may film or photograph participants and volunteers taking part or attending events and use such footage or photographs for commercial and/or fundraising use including, but not limited to: advertising, publications, marketing material, merchandising, and other documents made available to the public; and for our sponsors/partners to publicise their involvement or association with the event.



Please note, photos and videos may come from a wide range of sources (including spectators) and is sometimes not arranged by St Helena Hospice. If approached by a photographer or videographer and you do not wish to be filmed or photographed, please let them know. We do, however, reserve the right to use footage or images supplied to us where you might be included.

6.2 No personal details (including names) of anyone under 18 years old will be used in any publicity materials without the written consent of their parent or legal quardian, but we may use images where children are incidentally included.

7. Property and liability

- 7.1. The organisers are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
- 7.2. You are liable for any damage you cause to event property or others' property during the event.

8. Activities and participation

- 8.1. Certain activities may have age or safety restrictions. Please adhere to these guidelines.
- 8.2. Parents and guardians are responsible for always supervising their children.
- 8.3. Participation in event activities is at your own risk. Organisers are not liable for injuries or accidents that occur during the event.

9. Vendors and exhibitors

- 9.1. Vendors and exhibitors must comply with all event rules and local regulations.
- 9.2. Sales of prohibited items, dangerous materials, or counterfeit goods are strictly forbidden.

10. Cancellation and changes

- 10.1. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or reschedule the event due to unforeseen circumstances (e.g., weather, safety concerns).
- 10.2. The organisers will communicate any significant changes or cancellations in a timely manner.

11. Data protection and privacy

- 11.1. The organisers may collect and use personal information for event administration and future promotional purposes. This data will not be shared with third parties without your consent.
- 11.2. You have the right to access, update, or request the deletion of your personal information.

12. Governing law



12.1. These terms are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United Kingdom.
